In the early 1980s, White started a training partnership with Harley-Davidson USA that set the stage for a successful strategy to work closely with leading manufacturers in creating and delivering education offerings that would best prepare technicians to enter the workforce. Soon after, exclusive relationships with American Honda Motor Co., Yamaha Motor Corporation, U.S.A., Kawasaki Motors Corp. U.S.A. and Suzuki Motor of America, Inc. would follow. By 1987, with an expansion to Orlando, White had grown MMI into the largest training enterprise of its kind in the world.

In 1997, MMI and UTI merged, and White became chairman of the board and chief strategic planning officer. His entrepreneurial spirit and visionary leadership have been key to UTI's business strategy, quality reputation and ongoing success.
